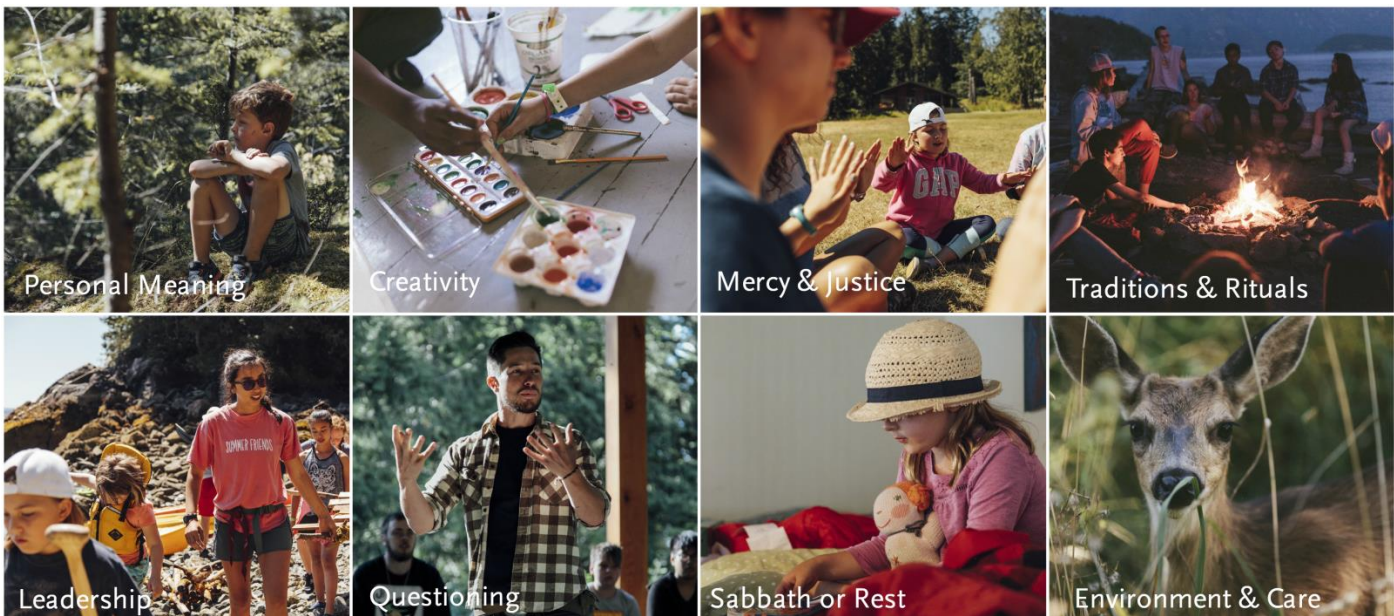
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Spiritual Life Coordinator

Job Title: Summer Camp & Spiritual Life Coordinator

Salary Band: Term Contract

Reports To: Summer Camp & Outdoor Schools Manager

Position 1 – Full-time staff member (5 days/week) June 1st-3rd + July 1st – August 17th

Position 2 – Contract staff member for Dad & Kids, Family Camp, and Kids Camp sessions 1 and 2

The Spiritual Life Coordinator will provide spiritual, mindful and reflection-based activities as part of the camp program structure. They will also assist in the day-to-day responsibilities of summer camp operations, working directly with the Program Coordinators.

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to) offering spiritual reflections and practices, discussion, and games/activities which engage participants in reflection about oneself, their relationship with something greater than themselves (god, earth, humanity, etc) and the community around them, encourage spiritual

inquiry and help them to navigate the complicated relationships and questions affecting and governing their lives at any given age.

Camp Fircom is seeking two Spiritual Life Coordinators per session of camp for summer 2018. The goal was to have two roles available: a full-time position throughout the entire season (5 days/week) and staff training dates; and another position for a variety of people to attend individual sessions of camp and the full-time role throughout the summer. Camp Fircom has hired one person already to do some individual sessions of camp and is open filling both openings each session with contractors.

Rooted in the values of the United Church camping (pictured on first page), Fircom respects and accepts people of all faith backgrounds, and no faith background, and seeks to help all individuals explore their own spirituality. Fircom is not evangelical but draws on the teachings of Christianity to offer and strengthen programming, which encourages spiritual exploration of all kinds.

EDUCATION & SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE

- Post-secondary degree in a relevant field (education background an asset).
- Minimum of two years' experience as a counsellor in a day camp or resident camp setting.
- Minimum of two years of camp leadership experience in a supervisory or management role.
- Knowledge of the organized camping industry and the requirements for delivery of high quality resident and day camp programs and outdoor education programming for schools and community groups.
- Valid certification for Standard First Aid & CPR C.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check.
